AUSTIN HANSON and Energy Transfer: A Partnership Fueled by Art, Passion, and Purpose





The Kleinworth Family Guest Suite was inspired by **CAROL** and **TOM KLEINWORTH'S** family experience during their brother Joe's end-of-life journey at Brookwood. Recognizing the importance of comfort and support for families during challenging times, the Kleinworth family made a gift to create a serene space where Citizen families can stay when they need to be close to their loved ones, whether during illness or other significant moments. Named in memory of CITIZEN **JOE KLEINWORTH**, this suite reflects the family's desire to make an ongoing difference in the lives of other Brookwood families.

In addition, the Kleinworth family wanted to honor **DR. TOMMY HARRISON**, Brookwood's first and ongoing on-site dental practitioner, who has been an instrumental figure in Citizen care.
